NEED HELP?

SafeCare Men's Group Treatment Program

This community-based specialist group treatment program is for men who have sexually offended against a child or are at risk of doing so as well as those who want to address issues relating to Problematic Internet Use (PIU) and/or charges of Child Exploitation Material (CEM) and other child sexual abuse internet offending.

The 20-30 weekly session program is based on a distillation of the Safecare treatment program which covers victim empathy training, childhood issues, relapse prevention strategies and Internet / CEM offending. The group program is available at a number of locations across Perth.

Women's Support Group

The SafeCare Women's Support Group meets fortnightly in Fremantle and welcomes women whose family members have offended. It provides a supportive environment for participants to discuss the wide range of issues that they face. Also available are the Women's Voices that were played at the 4th Perth Symposium on Child Sexual Abuse Prevention.
